

CIES Sexual and Reproductive Health Bolivia Commitment



Narrative:

CIES in Bolivia, in 2021 provided an average of 50,000 family planning services with a rights-based approach; by 2025, we will provide 200,000 family planning services to adult, young and adolescent women, contributing to women's right to decide. They are contraceptive services, which include counseling, medical consultation and others.

CIES in Bolivia, with the National Network of Youth Leaders Tú Decides (You Decide), provides information on FP annually to an average of 10,000 adolescents and young people. By 2025, the goal is to reach 30,000 adolescents and young people with information that contributes to making decisions about their reproductive life.

Outcomes:

200,000 female users have access to quality contraceptive services with a rights-based approach. Access and supply refers to clients who opt for a method and the contraceptive commodity is delivered.

80,000 Users (male and female) have access to contraceptive supplies.

30,000 adolescents and young people have access to information on contraception that contributes to informed decision making about their reproductive health.
