

Red Latinoamericana y Caribeña de Jóvenes por los Derechos Sexuales y Reproductivos (RedLAC) Commitment



Narrative:

Our region is one of the most unequal before the pandemic but also during it, some situations worsened and new ones arrived. And even though we recognize the advances in mechanisms such as the Montevideo Consensus, Central America continues to be the most criminalized when it comes to abortion; on the other hand the 2030 agenda that frames actions for the attention and prevention of violence, however the femicides of adolescents seem to continue to rise; finally the commitments made at the Nairobi Summit where Bolivia, Mexico and Argentina shone for their enthusiasm, we have seen few actions to see their fulfillment. This is why we at RedLAC are actively participating, on the one hand in advocacy spaces such as the coordination towards the CSW66, in the review of indicators for the Montevideo Consensus and the follow-up of the Beijing Platform for Action actions and workshops through our virtual classroom that allow us to disseminate the regional Sexual and Reproductive Rights Primer, the advocacy agendas and actions for the guarantee of health services for adolescents in the region.

Outcomes:

We are a network of organizations and collectives that work in the defense and promotion of sexual and reproductive rights in Latin America and the Caribbean, for our measurable commitments we have proposed the following:

1. 3 workshops within the virtual classroom on sexual and reproductive rights that impact at least 400 adolescents and young people.
2. Attendance and active participation in spaces such as CSW66 and CRPD.
3. We have a virtual classroom that allows us to conduct virtual workshops and the second is in terms of advocacy that we can do in the Commission on the Status of Women and the Regional Conference on Population and Development.
