Women Deliver Commitment

Narrative:



Support the increased capacity and knowledge sharing of 500 advocates, Women Deliver Young Leaders and youth, decision-makers, media, and women's rights organizations operating in development and humanitarian settings to influence investments, policies, and programs, including those related to access to modern contraception.

Fostering partnership and collaboration for increased advocacy impact by providing 100 opportunities for connecting for gender equality stakeholders to come together, strategize, and develop shared solutions in the lead-up to and at the Women Deliver 2023 Conference.

As a co-convener for the Alliance on Gender Equality and Universal Health Coverage, Women Deliver will advocate with global health leaders to ensure sexual and reproductive health (SRH) is nonnegotiable in UHC programs. This includes securing concrete commitments to ensure integration of SRH into UHC in key political agreements, particularly the second UN High-Level Meeting on UHC in September 2023. Additionally, the Women Deliver 2023 Conference will be an advocacy moment for the Alliance to build momentum in the lead up to the High-Level Meeting.

Outcomes:

1. Increased capacity and knowledge amongst women's rights organizations, youth, decision makers and marginalized communities to influence regional policies, programs, and resource allocations for gender equality and/or SRHR
